### \*National courses

- You will receive a Swedish grade from F-A
- Math: You can ask to do a national test (and get a grade) in Math 1c. Request in writing to your teacher by September 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Swedish: If you do not have a grade in Swedish as a 2<sup>nd</sup> language for compulsory school (school year 7-9) then you will not have Swedish in PreDP, you will have ab initio Swedish in DP 1.

### \*Preparation courses

The preparation courses will be graded according to IBDP scale 1-7. Prep courses are designed to both assess prior learning of the subject, develop skills in the subject area while also determining readiness and candidacy status for taking the subject in DP 1.

### \*Orientation courses

You do not receive grades or achievement levels. Orientation courses are designed to give the student a sampling of what the course is like so the student can decide their subject options for DP 1.

Remember, subject options for DP 1 are decided in tandem and agreement with the Diploma Programme Coordinator.

All final placement in courses is determined by the DP Coordinator and you may not get your first choice. Choose at least 3 at Higher Level, but not more than 4.
